

#### 1. Introduction


As part of a plain language movement across disciplines and industries, many scindiffic journals have begun to publish plain language summaries alongside more typical technical abstracts (Stoll et al., 2021; Nunn & Pinfield, 2044; Phipps et al., 2015; Hauck, 2019). These summaries contribute to making scientific research more accessible to non-experts. They help to meet calls for making scientific research discoverable (Flitzgibbon et al., 2020), accountable (Rosenberg et al., 2021) and more easily shared for public purposes (Jugas), 2021, as well as to increase the traceable reach of research online as measured by Altmetrics and other citation trackine metrics.






